TRAVEL PROTOCOLS

- Those attending large events (both indoors & outdoors taking place at theaters, amphitheatres, coliseums, stadiums, and convention centers) will be required to **present proof of vaccination with an FDA or WHO-approved vaccine as well as a negative COVID test taken in the 48 hours** prior to the event.
- All establishments serving food or drinks **must require proof of vaccination or a negative test taken within 48 hours prior upon arrival.**
- All passengers arriving on domestic flights are **required to show a negative test result taken within 48 hours before arrival time, regardless of vaccination status.** Passengers arriving without a test will have 48 hours to take one upon arrival or be subject to a fine. Unvaccinated travelers must quarantine for seven (7) days after arriving, regardless of whether they have a negative test result.
- Until January 31, 2022, those between 5 and 11 years old will be allowed to attend large indoor events by providing negative COVID-19 test results taken no more than 48 hours prior to the event. **Starting February 1, 2022, this age range will be subject to the same guidelines as adults, requiring proof of vaccination and negative test results taken within 48 hours prior to the event upon entry.** Children under 5 years of age will not be allowed to attend large-scale events, even with negative results, except when permitted by the Department of Health.

WHILE ON THE ISLAND

- **Mask usage is a federal law on airplanes and in airports.** Those entering any of the Island's three open airports, whether on commercial or private aircraft, are required to fill out a Travel Declaration Form on the Puerto Rico Health Department's online portal (www.travelsafe.pr.gov), which produces a QR code to proceed. Passengers need to present a valid ID to ensure alignment with the Travel Declaration Form. - The Luis Muñoz Marín International Airport (SJU) offers PCR molecular COVID-19 tests on-site for incoming and outgoing passengers. The service, which costs \$110 USD, is offered from 6:00AM to 8:00PM, seven days a week, at three molecular test collection centers located at terminals A, B, and C. More information is available here. The Johnson and Johnson vaccine is also available in Terminal B at Luis Muñoz Marín International Airport (SJU).
- **Masks are required indoors, regardless of age or vaccination status.** Those unvaccinated or between the ages of 2 and 11 must also wear masks in public areas when unable to social distance. Masks are required at all outdoor activities of 50 attendees or more. This requirement does not apply to public beaches. Masks are still recommended in crowded urban areas.
- Beaches will be open for recreational use following social distancing guidelines.
- **Vaccinations are required for both employees and guests of all hotels** across the Island. Those not vaccinated must present a negative PCR or antigen test taken within 72 hours of the beginning of their visit. If staying longer than one week, they must continue to present negative tests on a weekly basis. Those not vaccinated due to medical or religious reasons must provide proper documentation confirming this and are still required to present negative tests on a weekly basis.
- All establishments serving food or drinks **must require proof of vaccination or negative test taken within 48 hours prior upon arrival.** Employees of all restaurants, food courts, bars, chinchorros, or indoor dining locations must be vaccinated or provide weekly negative tests. **Effective December 30, 2021,** all restaurant, bars, movie theaters, amphitheatres, sports bars, stadiums, casinos, convention centers and other locations serving prepared food and beverages shall reduce its operational capacity to 50% of its maximum capacity, if enclosed, and to 75% of its maximum capacity, if outdoor.

COVID-19 TESTING

Since Puerto Rico is a U.S. territory, the recent CDC COVID-19 testing requirements for U.S. travelers re-entering the U.S. from overseas international destinations does not apply, and you will not need a negative test to return to your state. www.cdc.gov/media/releases

Should you require a **COVID-19 test**, the following options are available:



DOCTOR ON CALL (787-692-2072)

Each doctor's visit at the resort is \$200 and does not include the cost of testing.

- Antibody blood test
- Antigen test (*similar to molecular*)
- Molecular test
 - Results within 24-hrs
 - Results within 72-hrs

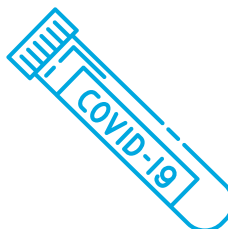
